Here at Landewednack School & Little Lizards we understand completely any concerns or worries you may have as parents during these unsettled times. We would like to take this opportunity to reassure all of our parents and their families that we are constantly following all of the current guidelines to ensure that we are offering a safe environment for our children and staff. We have a strict cleaning and sanitising programme which includes door handles and table tops - this is carried out thoroughly each evening. Shona, our site manager is using much stronger cleaning products which are proven to kill the virus. We are asking to help us keep everyone safe, that parents please advise us on any change to the health and wellbeing of any family member within their bubble. If a member of your family is taking and then awaiting the results of a Covid-19 test, please do not send your children in to school unless the test is negative. Please also be advised that there will be no breech of confidentially with any information you may provide us with. Thank you again for your continued cooperation and support.



If your child or their sibling from another school/nursery has been advised to take a Covid-19 test, please inform the school or Little Lizards immediately. Your child and any siblings must not return school or nursery until the test has come back negative. Please be assured that any information you give us will be treated in the strictest confidence.

A polite reminder that if a family member should test positive for Covid-19, the whole household must self-isolate for 14 days. When a family member has symptoms the whole household must isolate until a negative test result is received or for 14 days, providing they do not become symptomatic.

Absence from school under these circumstances only will not count against your child.
