Head lice!



Class Dojo app to share learning with parents

We are always trying to update our ways of communicating with parents and carers to ensure that we stay in touch about the welfare and learning of our children and to celebrate their achievements. To help with this, we have decided to start using the Class Dojo communication platform. Class Dojo is an online platform that means:

- Teachers and parents can send messages (only seen by parent and teacher).
- Parents can view the "class story" where teachers can post updates about learning, reminders, links, photos etc. (seen by all parents in class).
- Parents can see a report of student's SHINE points as they receive them (only seen by parent).

Important things to remember...

- You still need to ring the office if your child is absent from school.
- Teachers will only reply to messages between the hours of 8am and 5pm on school days. However, please remember that we teach your children from 8.45am-3.15pm, so it may take some time to receive a response.
- The parent Class Dojo app is free to download but will advertise a paid version of the app that lets you use the Class Dojo points system at home. We are not suggesting that you purchase this and it is not necessary to buy it in order to communicate with teachers, see the class story or view a report of your child's SHINE points in school.

All of the information you give will be kept private and the Class Dojo privacy policy states that no information will be passed on, in line with GDPR. Please follow the link to read the privacy policy https://www.classdojo.com/privacy/

If you consent to using Class Dojo to communicate with teachers, view your child's SHINE point report and view the class story, please sign up for it using the code on your personalised letter (also emailed to the email addresses we hold for parents and carers. Please ensure this is up to date with the office.) These will be sent out after half term.














READY STEADY READ


