What sort of words are they? Nouns? Adjectives? Verbs? Adverbs?

They are all verbs. Remember, verbs tell us that someone or something is doing, feeling or being. They are action words.

The men arrived.

The creatures worried.

The forest is silent.

Verbs have tense. They tell us when the action happened.

<u>Past</u>	<u>Present</u>
The men arrived in the forest.	The men arrive in the forest.
We watched.	We <mark>watch</mark> .
The man slept.	The man sleeps.
