School & PE Kit Reminder

We take pride in our children's appearance and ask that they wear full school uniform every day with the exception of their PE or Wild Tribe day. Those days are as follows:

Pufflings - Tuesday, Puffins - Tuesday, Choughs - Wednesday & Thursday, Razorbills - Monday & Friday

School uniform consists of a white shirt/polo shirt, green jumper/cardigan/fleece and a grey skirt/pinafore dress/ trousers/short. PE kit is the yellow Landewednack School t-shirt and green shorts or black joggers/leggings and trainers.

We do also appreciate that some children have grown out of their leather school shoe, so with this in mind and with the summer fast approaching we ask that children STILL wear a black shoe. This can be a smart trainer or canvas shoe just for the summer term.

Headlice

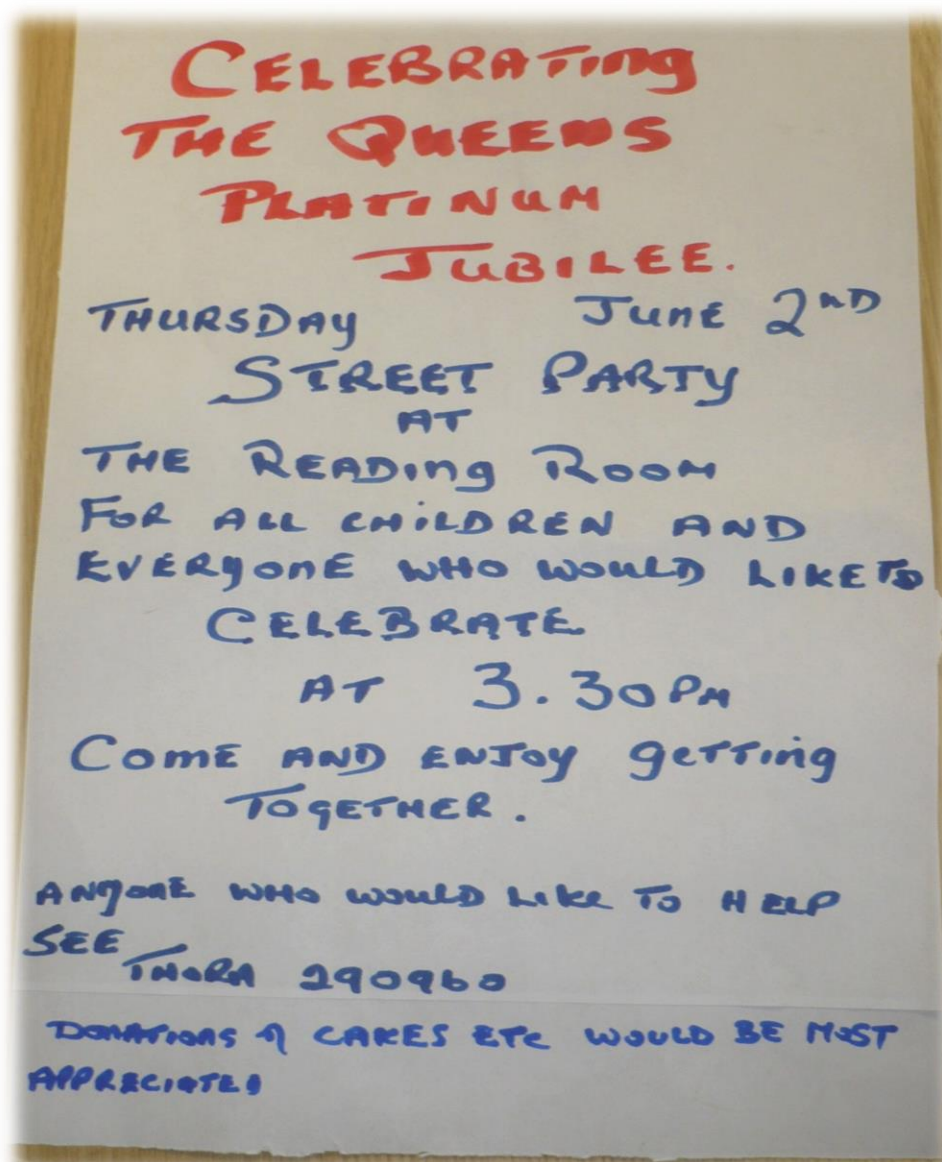
Unfortunately, we have received reports of headlice within the school. Please could parents check their children's hair and treat headlice where necessary to help us eradicate this ongoing problem.

A Message from Mrs Jones

Just a reminder that now Covid restrictions have ended, thankfully we no longer have to keep you all at a distance!

We don't want to keep you waiting out on the road, so we will make sure the front gate is open before the 8:45 start of school; feel free to wait with your child inside of the gates away from the road. Mrs Bray will be around for messages and reminders but if you wish to speak to your child's teacher, just let us know. Please make sure your child does not arrive before 8:40 as there will be nobody on duty. Mrs Tattersall will be at the back gate by Croft Park between 8.45 and 8.55 as normal.

Nursery parents- you are more than welcome to come in off the road and wait with your child(ren) for Little Lizards (wooden) gate to be opened. For the rest of the school, the children can come straight in at 8:45- the door will be open!

Again, after school we are happy for Puffins parents to wait for their children on the Puffins playground (inside the gates) and for the rest of the school, just inside our main gate. We hope this will make 'pick up' time a little safer :)
