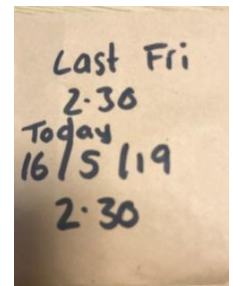
### Cross Country
