

- Could all children please bring sun hats and sun cream (labelled)- Please can children have sun cream on when they arrive (staff will have some at Little Lizards for those who forget) Children who require a special medicated sun cream please ensure this is with them at all times or please give to a member of staff.
- There are an increasing number of parents dropping off during breakfast club time. Please be reminded that if your child's funding starts at 8:45am then any admissions into Little Lizards before this time will be charged. Alternatively if funding starts at 9am then an early admission fee will also be charged. This is a really busy time for staff that are still preparing for the day and taking the Breakfast Club children into school.
