## Countrywide School Keep Clear Markings

On behalf of Cornwall Council, Cormac Solutions have reviewed primary and secondary schools in Cornwall and as a result we will have our existing "School Keep Clear" lines remarked. A reminder that the January payment (£25.00) for the year 5/6 school camp is now due. Please place all payments clearly marked in the black box by the office door.


#### Violin Lessons
