# Free School Meals and Pupil Premium

Here at Landewednack we are very aware that current circumstances for many of our families may have changed over the last few months. Are you in receipt of one of the benefits listed below? If you are, your child/children would be entitled to Free School Meals and Pupil Premium.

This means that the school would receive extra funding, which is currently £1300 per child. This money is used to target the needs of that child.

- Universal Credit with net ('take-home') income not exceeding £7,400 (£616.67 per month)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190, as assessed by HMRC
- Working Tax Credit run-on-paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
