## Attendance

A polite reminder, that unless for exceptional circumstances or illness, any child absence from school will be marked in our registers as unauthorised. Though we understand the reasons why holidays are taken during school time, we are becoming increasingly concerned about the number of time some of our children are spending away from school. As from the 1st September 2013, Head teachers were no longer able to authorise any holiday in term time. Please be aware that an accumulation of Unauthorised Absence could lead to prosecution under the Education Act 1996.

### DID YOU KNOW?

- there are 190 days to be at school and 175 to be on holiday
- 90% attendance equates to missing 6 months of school over 5 years
- if a child's attendance drops to 90% the Government categorises them as a persistent absentee
- 80% attendance means a child misses school one day a week and a whole year out of 5


