## Our Eden Adventure!







Dear parents 17th May 2023

As part of our 'Learning Means the World' (LMTW) curriculum, our theme this term is 'Conservation'. The children have been learning about habitats and homes; climates including the rainforest; the conservation of animals and insects; plants and growth; how energy is produced and the conservation of the world's energy to name but a few! We are encouraging our children to talk about their learning as this helps them to remember, so please do ask them to talk to you about our Conservation topic.

To enrich our topic and to celebrate the wonderful learning, we have a surprise for the children- we are lucky to have the opportunity to take all of our school-aged children (from Reception to Year 6) to the Eden Project. This will be next week on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> May. Together as a school family we will be exploring the biomes and the education centre as well as taking part in some exciting workshops with the Eden team, linked closely to our learning in school.

We will be leaving school after morning register (by coach or minibus) and aim to be back at school at approximately 4:00pm. We realise that this is slightly later than normal end of school; we hope you agree that this will be a wonderful experience for them.

Your child will need to wear their school uniform with comfortable (walking) shoes or trainers and bring a packed lunch (with enough for a snack) and a water bottle. Our kitchen can provide a school packed lunch-please order this via Dojo message to Mrs Tattersall by Friday.

Learning outside the classroom is widely recognised as a valuable and effective means of extending knowledge, enriching understanding and promoting personal and social development. We believe wholeheartedly in the value of these experiences and subsidise the cost of all visits as much as possible in an attempt to ensure that these opportunities are accessible and affordable to all. However, schools seldom have the financial resources to pay the full costs. Consequently, we are asking for a contribution of £9 per child to go towards the cost of the workshops and transport. Mrs Tattersall will set this up on Parent Pay.

We are so grateful for your contributions, which enable us, despite our distance from many activities, to provide the children with fun and exciting days to remember as well as making their learning 'real'. We are looking forward to our day at Eden together and will send pictures via Dojo.

As you have already signed the annual consent form, there is no need give consent again, please get in touch if you have any queries.

#### Monies Owed
