Our Theatre Trip!



Dear parents,

The Christmas season is nearly here and we would like to give our children the chance to enjoy one of our great British traditions - the pantomime!

We are lucky to have the opportunity to take all of our school-aged children (from Reception to Year 6) to the Hall for Cornwall to see Peter Pan. This will be a special performance for schools so will be lively and interactive. The trip will be near the end of term, on Friday 15th December. We loved exploring the Eden Project together as a school family last year and we are looking forward to our children enjoying their time together at the theatre.

We will be leaving school after morning register (by coach or minibus), the Pantomime starts at 11:00am so we will be back in plenty of time before the end of the school day. Your child will need to wear their school uniform and bring a packed lunch and a water bottle. Our kitchen can provide a school packed lunch - please order this via Dojo message to Mrs Tattersall by Monday 11th December.

Visiting the theatre to watch a live performance is a valuable and enriching experience; it encourages creativeness and inspires children to use their imagination. As I have mentioned before, we believe wholeheartedly in the value of these experiences and subsidise the cost of all visits as much as possible in an attempt to ensure that these opportunities are accessible and affordable to all. However, schools seldom have the financial resources to pay the full costs. Consequently, we are asking for a contribution of £10 per child to go towards the cost of the pantomime and transport. Mrs Tattersall will set this up on Parent Pay.

We are grateful to our newly formed PTFA who will be working towards enabling the children to enjoy more trips and visits with less cost to parents in the future. Please do support them at the upcoming Christmas Fayre (look out for more details) and events throughout the year. We are so grateful for your contributions which enable us, despite our distance from many activities and venues, to provide the children with fun, exciting and valuable days to remember. As you have already signed the annual consent form, there is no need give consent again; please get in touch if you have any queries. We are looking forward to our trip to the pantomime together- we will have so much fun- 'oh yes we will!'
