With half term around the corner, members of Balanceability have asked us to pass on this message.....



Unfortunately accidents do happen. Every year children are taken to hospital with injuries caused from riding a bike and a lot of these are head injuries which is why helmets are so important.

Establish the helmet habit early when children start their cycling journey. If they learn to wear helmets whenever they ride it will become a habit for a lifetime.

There are important points to remember -

- Make sure the helmet fits the child.
- Ensure the helmet is put on the correct way round.
- Treat the helmet with care as if damaged it won't protect the child as well when you need it.
- If a child falls off and hits their head, replace the helmet.
