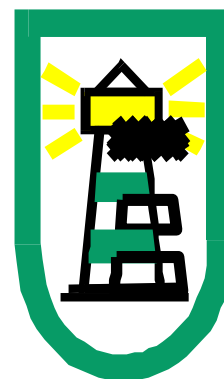

Thank you to everyone who came to our Christmas Fair. Special thanks to our School Association, those who donated raffle prizes, refreshments and their time throughout the afternoon.

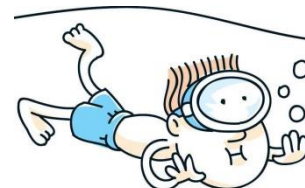


Christmas Jumper Day

The cost of our Christmas lunch will be £2.20 and can be paid for in the usual manner.

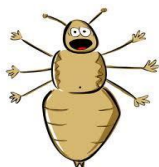


Packed Lunches
