Group 3 - Ellie, Jessica, Hector - 2nd & 9th May



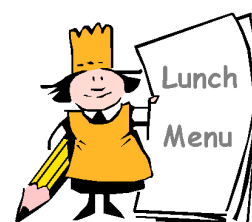
Easter Fair - 23rd March

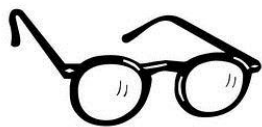
