#### ParentPay - A NEW message from Mrs Tattersall

Thank you to those parents who have activated their ParentPay accounts and are now using it to pay for things. I hope you are finding it makes your life a little easier now you have it set up! <u>If you haven't yet, please could you log on as soon as possible and activate your account</u>. Letters with activation information have gone home to those who haven't yet activated their accounts. If you have any problem or haven't had your letter with your child's password, please pop in and see me (with your smartphone) and I will try and help.

<u>Starting this term, I have to put all monies owed by parents on to ParentPay to allow ALL payments to be made through it, whether for dinner money, bookbags, or school trips etc....</u>

Little Lizards' invoices that you have received this month should now be on ParentPay. If you have received a paper invoice and it's not on ParentPay please let me know and I will add it. Once the MAT office have caught up with putting cheque, cash and direct bank transfer payments on, the accounts system, I will add any outstanding invoices to it as well.

You will have noticed when you pay for dinner money that it comes up with a default payment of  $\pounds 2.30$ . This is because I have to put a default amount in to allow me to create a payment item and that is the cost of one dinner; for Little Lizards it is  $\pounds 4$  because that is our cheapest session. This doesn't mean that is what you owe, it should also tell you what your balance is. For dinner money the MAT expect parents to stay in credit at all times please.

I know this is a lot of information to take in, but please bear with us through any teething problems, as it's new to us too. Thank you so much for your help in getting this new payment system working for our school, hopefully it will make our life and yours a lot easier!
