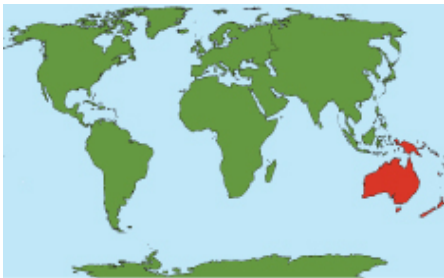


Fact-file Oceania

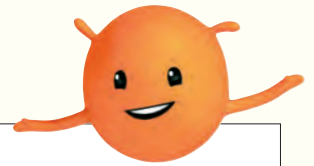


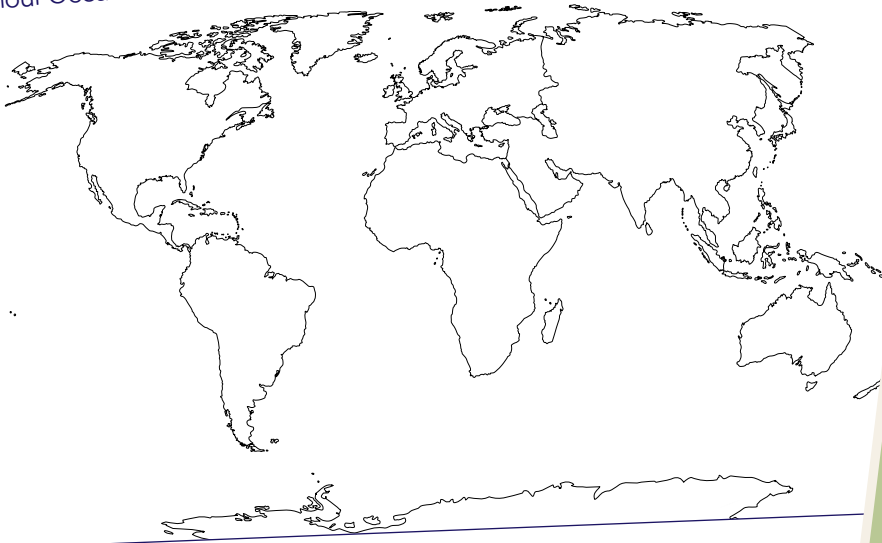
