

A new messaging service has been launched in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly to link young people and families with health visitors and school nurses. Called *Chat Health*, it aims to provide a quick and easy way to access health advice and support.

There are three dedicated numbers:

- Young people aged 11-19 can call 07312 263 096
- Parents or carers of children aged 0-5 can call 07312 263 423
- Parents or carers of children and young people aged 5-19 can call 07312 263 499

When a text message is sent, an automated reply confirms it has been received. A trained healthcare professional within the health visiting or school nursing teams will then reply within 48 hours.

Funded by the government's Start for Life programme, the new service fully launches on Monday, January 22, and will be available Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays) from 9am to 5pm.

Confidential help and advice are available for a range of health concerns.
