#### Sports Day

#### Junior Summer Production - "Treasure Island"

Our junior children are busy rehearsing for their summer production of Treasure Island. Performances will take place on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> July at 2pm and 7pm and Wednesday 19th July at 7pm. Each family will be allocated 2 seats which can be on the date and time of your choice. As with last year we will not be issuing tickets, but asking parents to see Lyndsay Bray who will add your name to the seating lists. We appreciate that there may be several members of your family wishing to see our play but ask that only 2 seats are reserved in the first instance to allow all of our families the chance to see the show. We are usually able to accommodate all of your seating requests and may be able to offer more seats if there are any available prior to each show.

The evening performances require the children to be at school from 6.30pm and not before please.

Mrs Green and all of the staff have been working hard with the children helping them to learn their lines and the songs. Every junior child has been given a part in the show and it is vital that they attend every performance.
