Remembrance Sunday






Christmas Dinner Day

The cost of Christmas Lunch is £2.34 and can be paid for in the usual manner, via your child's ParentPay account.















The main symptoms of COVID-19 are:


a high temperature

a new, continuous cough - this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours

a loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If your child has any of the main symptoms of COVID-19, even if they're mild PLEASE get a PCR test (test that is sent to a lab) to check if they have COVID-19 as soon as possible. Your child should stay at home and not have visitors (self-isolate) until you get the test result - they can only leave home to have the test. https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test
