Sunhats, Sun Cream & Water Bottle

We are currently unable to use our dishwasher and are finding that hygienically washing the cups the children use each day to be a problem. Therefore we are asking that the children bring their own bottle filled with water only.

School Lunch for current Little Lizards - Going in to Reception

Parents of children in Little Lizards will be interested to know that when their children begin school in September they will be entitled to a free government funded school meal each day. This will continue until the end of Year 2.

A reminder for the parents of our current Year 2 children in Choughs Class that from September your child will become a Year 3 pupil and will therefore no longer be entitled to a government funded free school meal. Little Lizards Notices

- Could all children please bring sun hats and sun cream (labelled)- Please can children have sun cream on when they arrive (staff will have some at Little Lizards for those who forget) Children who require a special medicated sun cream please ensure this is with them at all times or please give to a member of staff.
- There are an increasing number of parents dropping off during breakfast club time. Please be reminded that if your child's funding starts at 8:45am then any admissions into Little Lizards before this time will be charged. Alternatively if funding starts at 9am then an early admission fee will also be charged. This is a really busy time for staff that are still preparing for the day and taking the Breakfast Club children into school.
- Please ensure that your children are collected at the end of their session time. Another reminder that charges are payable for late pick up.
- Can all children bring a spare change of clothes everyday (including socks) Now that the weather is warming up we will have more water play and activities outside. Also children in nappies need to have wipes provided as well.
- All children need to bring a water bottle each day (labelled) - now it is warming up it is important the children can stay hydrated and access their own bottles. A reminder also that grapes need to be cut in half in the children's lunch boxes, as left whole this could be a choking hazard.
- Bookings for September - please start booking your children in for September 2019 for day care, pop into Little Lizards to see a member of staff.



SWIMMING LESSONS

Kennack Sands Beach through the school holidays!

Hello, I am a qualified swimming teacher and coach and I will be running children and adult sea swim lessons through July/ August. Children need to be able to swim a little, (doggy paddle is fine) as these sessions are designed to show the swimmers the difference in swimming in a pool and the sea. They will learn survival skills, lifeguard rules and how to spot a rip current/ choosing a safe place to take a swim. Lessons are 30mins and are £6 a child.

They need: Wetsuit and Beach Shoes (This is essential as the sea temperature is significantly lower than the average pool and with the weather heating up it also increases the risks of treading on a weaver fish in the sand) Adults don't need to come in the sea for the lessons but they will need to be on the beach and in the designated area to make it easy to spot if their child should need something and for collection at the end of the lessons.
