A Letter from Mrs Jones

Dear Parents,

We have had a wonderful term celebrating the success of our recent Ofsted inspection and welcoming visitors who have been keen to learn from the excellent practice here at Landewednack. I am incredibly proud of our staff and children for the way they showcase our school's strengths.

As we approach the end of term, I am writing to share some exciting news and confirm our class structure for September 2026.

From September, Miss Carey will be stepping up into the role of Head of School. As you know, Miss Carey has already made a huge contribution to Landewednack as our Year 5/6 teacher and Assistant Head, leading many areas of the school and curriculum with great skill and dedication. I am delighted that she will now take on this new leadership role.

My own role will change slightly next year, as I become Executive Headteacher across Landewednack and another primary school, Kehelland. Each school will have its own Head of School, and I will work closely with both to share good practice, strengthen links, and develop new ideas. This arrangement is initially for one year, and I am genuinely excited to support two talented leaders and continue to ensure that our children remain at the heart of everything we do.

I will continue to be based at Landewednack for two days each week and at Kehelland for two, so you will still see me regularly around school. Many of you are already familiar with my working pattern, and this change simply brings additional expertise and collaboration to benefit our pupils.

Looking ahead, our priorities for next year include continuing to build on our excellent curriculum, embedding the new TPAT 'Connected' writing curriculum, and further developing children's foundational skills such as handwriting, spelling and number fluency as well as learning behaviours such as growth mindset, and readiness to learn. Our Early Years provision is already a strength and continues to have a positive impact on progress throughout the school. Next year, we will further evolve our nursery provision, embedding our 'Total Communication' approach, developing speech and language from the earliest stages. We will also deepen our focus on inclusion, further exploring how children learn in different ways and environments. Alongside this, we are building on our already excellent programme of personal development and enrichment activities. Teachers will share their curriculum units with you at the start of each term, beginning in the autumn. As always, we welcome any ideas, resources, or expertise you may wish to share.

You will be pleased to know that our class structure will remain the same:

- **Little Lizards EYFS**- 2-year olds to pre-school with Reception joining for part of the day to enable them to experience their full EYFS curriculum.
- **Puffins Class** – Mrs O'Neil (Reception, Year 1, Year 2)
- **Choughs Class** – Miss Honey (Year 3, Year 4)
- **Razorbills Class** – Miss Carey (Year 5, Year 6)



The children have already begun transition activities and are looking forward to our Move-Up Day on Wednesday 1st July, when they will spend the day in their new classes.

Thank you for your continued support and trust. I want to reassure you that, whatever changes come, my commitment to putting the children first remains unwavering. Landewednack will continue to thrive as a happy, nurturing, and ambitious school community.
