I hope you all had a lovely world book day and St Piran's day. Thank you for all your support in celebrating our children and their love of reading. The children had a great time and got to try lots new books!


Just a reminder that, although we no longer have reading records (due to feedback that it took away from actual reading time), we do encourage children to read at home as much as possible. This includes children reading their school reading book (the levelled book that they take home from RWI Phonics or the school library), reading together, and being read to.

We read with the children every day in school in DEAR time and whole class reading/ phonics lessons, plus extra reading with Taz & Barty, and Sarah and our wonderful team of TAs and teachers.
