- Celebrate good and improving attendance across the school

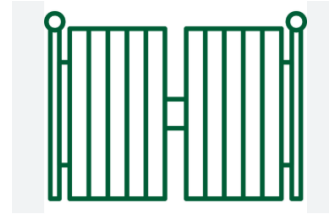

Please could we politely remind our Puffins children and their grown-ups that as part of our safeguarding procedures, they should come in to school each morning via their own gate and not the main front door. (Unless running late of course).



Mrs O'Neill and Mrs Humby are ready and waiting to greet the children each morning when their timetable begins. The gate opens at 8,30am and is closed ready to start the school day at 8,40pm. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

Please can we ask that vehicles are not parked on or opposite the yellow zig-zag lines especially at the start or end of the school/nursery day.
