Pupil Attendance

As parents are most probably aware, there is a national drive for improved attendance in schools. To this end, the Truro & Penwith Academy Trust are monitoring our attendance. They have asked us to make sure we record the exact reason a child is off.



If we are recording a child with an attendance mark of 'ill', 'not feeling well' is no longer an acceptable comment, and we are expected to put a description of their illness.

There may also be occasions, if a child is persistently absent, that we ask for a doctor's note. Thank you for your understanding of our position and helping us to comply with this expectation.

Reminders - Thank you in advance...

- Please could all long hair be tied back securely everyday in school and Little Lizards. We have had reports of headlice doing the rounds again as well long flowing hair being a hygiene and potential safety issue.
- We ask that the children only consume HEALTHY SNACKS at morning break please.
