Dear parents

We have arranged a trip to take our school children (Year R to Year 6) to Penrose Walks, Helston. This will be on Tuesday (23rd June). We will be joined by the team from CAST (Cornubian Arts and Science Trust) who have planned a creative activity day; there will be a sensory/adventure trail to the walled garden and lots of activities once there.

We will be travelling either by coach or minibus and will be leaving at 8:45, so we can meet the team and begin our trail to the walled garden. We will be opening our doors slightly earlier than 8:30 to give the children chance to arrive and be registered. We will be leaving the fairground car park at 3:00 so we should be back at school at 3:30. Bearing in mind the summer traffic, we may be slightly later than this - we will keep you updated throughout the journey via Dojo.

Your child will need:

- Sun hat and sun cream applied before leaving (we will also bring Boots Soltan, please let us know if your child CANNOT use this cream)
- A back pack containing a packed lunch, a mid-morning snack, water bottle and a waterproof -
- Sensible walking shoes e.g. trainers - NO Crocs, sandals or boots.

This trip will be a wonderful opportunity for the children to deepen their understanding of our local environment through art, history, sensory exploration and simple map-reading activities. We are also excited to spend time together as a school community, enjoying nature and learning in such a beautiful setting.

We are really lucky that the PTFA have agreed to fund the full amount of this trip (and will be funding a trip for the nursery too). The only way we can do this is with the help and support of our school community; a few hours of your time can make a big difference to all of our children's educational experience.

Your help at fundraising events is greatly appreciated.
