Young people are offered the following vaccines in secondary school:

Vaccine	School year offered	Diseases protected against
Flu vaccine	Annual vaccine offered to all in Years 7 to 11	Protects against flu, which can lead to acute bronchitis and pneumonia
Human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine	Year 8	HPV related cancers such as cervical cancer, some cancers of the head and neck, some genital cancers and genital warts
MenACWY vaccine	Year 9	Meningococcal groups A, C, W and Y (which can cause meningitis and septicaemia)
3 in 1 teenage booster (Td/IPV)	Year 9	Tetanus, diphtheria and polio
MMR – for those that have not had 2 doses of MMR	Catch-up – offered opportunistically	Measles, mumps and rubella

Catch-up opportunities, either as additional visits or when the immunisation team is already coming into the school, may be offered for those who have missed out on their vaccinations.

The Kernow Health team will be back at Landewednack on Tuesday 12th November to administer the Nasal Flu vaccine to those children whose parents have consented. Further information and consent forms will be sent out in the autumn term and nearer to that November date.

Our current Year 6 children (soon to be Year 7) will also be offered this vaccine at Secondary School plus others which are listed on the above poster for parent's information.

Dear Parents,

As part of our rich and broad curriculum at Landewednack School, we aim to promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive taught programme of Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education that gives our children the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live healthy, safe productive and fulfilled lives.

This subject includes progressive modules on Relationships and Sex Education (RSE), which include topics relating to physical and mental health, wellbeing, safeguarding, healthy relationships and the emotional and physical aspects of growing up. Relationships and Health Education is statutory and forms part of the National Curriculum. Statutory guidance can be found at

Kate Hughes has had specific training in this area and is incredibly knowledgeable; she delivers much of the PSHE and RSE content.
