The PTFA would like to see if there would be sufficient interest if they were to run a 100 club, with the sole purpose to raise funds for the PTFA? The money will be paid into the PTFA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, transport, resources and opportunities to enrich our children's education.

The rules would probably be:

1. For a cost of £1 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between one and 100.

2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.

3. The prizes will total 45% of the annual income.

4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 20%, 2nd prize of 10% and 3rd prize of 5% for 10 out of 12 months. The prizes for June and December will be higher with a 1st prize of 50%, 2nd prize of 25% and 3rd prize of 15% of the monthly income

5. The 100 club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Landewednack School. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.

6. Numbers are limited to two per household.

7. Payments must be made by standing order (preferably annually) or annual cheque. One month's notice is required for cancellation

8. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription/payment is up to date.

9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.

10. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on DoJo and on the school website.

11. The 100 club will be run by the PTFA. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.

12. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.

13. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTFA funds after six months.
